## **Duck Derby Boat Race**

- 1. Each team will consist of 5 people (all ages) All five are allowed to build. The person captaining the ship counts as one of the five builders.**
- 2. Team fee is \$50.00**
- 3. Each team will be given 60 minutes in which to build a boat from approved cardboard. The boat must be able to hold its Captain.**
- 4. At the end of 60 minutes, all boats will be taken to the pool to see which boats can survive a trip down the pool AND BACK.**
- 5. The Captain must be in the boat, not in the water pushing or pulling it. At the start, all boats will be in the water touching the side of the pool.**
- 6. Boats will attempt to make it from one side to the other and back to their starting point. Teammates may not help the boats in any way at the halfway point.**
- 7. If the person falls out of the boat, they must get back in and start at the spot where they fell out. No forward progress may be made until back in the boat.**
- 8. Cardboard cannot exceed 1" in thickness, before being taped. Cardboard tubes can be used, but cannot exceed 1" in thickness or 3" in diameter before being taped. The boat may be no more than TWELVE FEET LONG and EIGHT FEET WIDE.**
- 9. The team must provide cardboard, tape, and any building supplies. Paddles will be provided by the pool.**
- 10. The fastest time will be the winner. Prizes will be given to the top three teams.**
